

Detailed Directions on How to Paginate:



1. Print out the page with cover and back page on it.
2. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **2 and 39** on it.
3. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **38 and 3** on it.
4. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **4 and 37** on it.
5. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **36 and 5** on it.
6. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **6 and 35** on it.
7. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **34 and 7** on it.
8. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **8 and 33** on it.
9. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **32 and 9** on it.
10. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **10 and 31** on it.
11. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **30 and 11** on it.
12. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **12 and 29** on it.
13. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **28 and 13** on it.
14. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **14 and 27** on it.
15. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **26 and 15** on it.
16. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **16 and 25** on it.
17. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **24 and 17** on it.
18. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **18 and 23** on it.
19. On a new paper, print out the page that has page numbers **22 and 19** on it.
20. On the back side of the page you printed, print out the page that has page numbers **20 and 21** on it.
21. Place the first page face down (the page numbers facing up should be **2 and 39**).
22. Place all pages in order on top of each other.
23. Fold and staple
